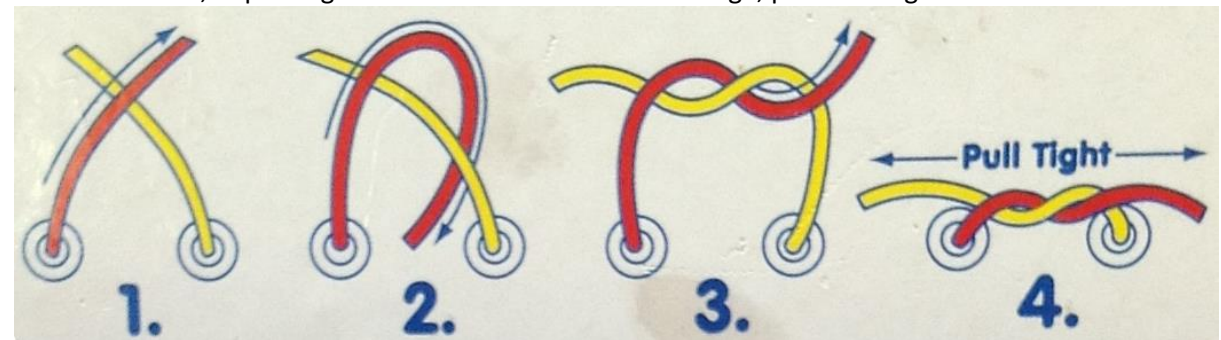


How to tie Shoelaces:

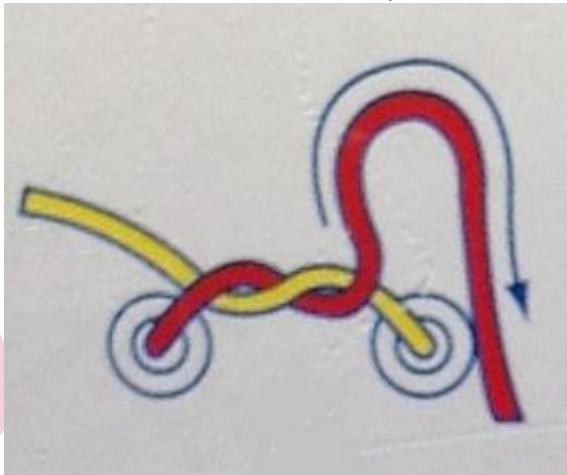
Step 1:

Cross laces over, Top lace goes over and then under the bridge, pull laces tight

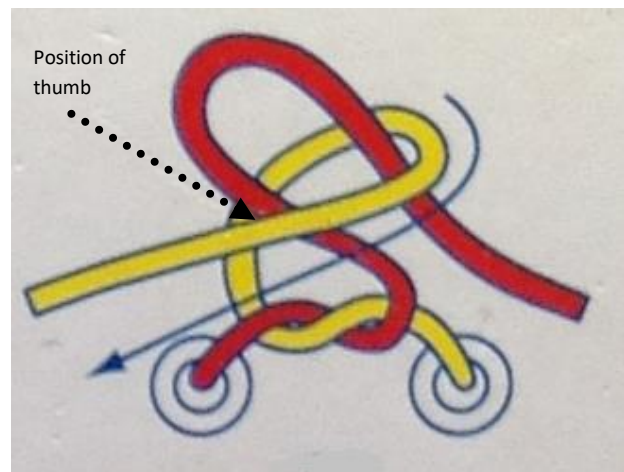


Step 2:

1. Make a bush with the lace on the preferred hand side. Make sure you hold the bush close to the shoe (because bushes can't fly ☺)

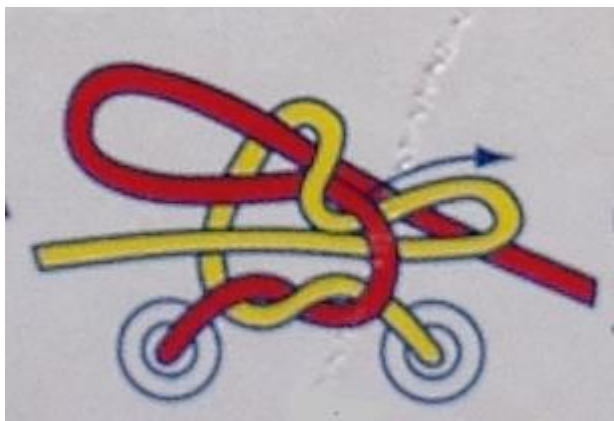
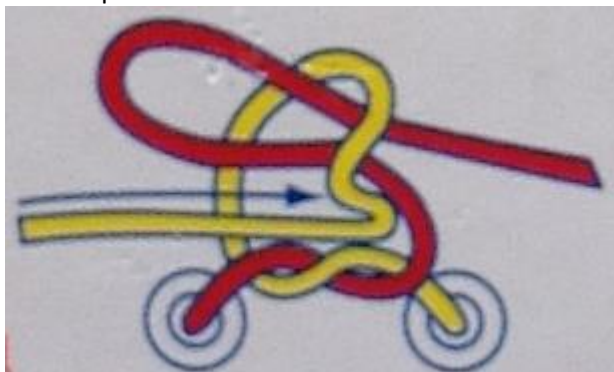


2. Take the other lace and the bunny goes around the bush, visiting the thumb then peter pointer, creating a bunny burrow where the preferred hands thumb is



holding the bush

3. Push the bunny into the burrow, to visit the thumb again. Remember that the bush (the first loop) is still being held still by the preferred hand!



4. While continuing to hold the bush with the preferred hand take hold of the top of the bush with the non preferred hand. Once holding the bush with the non preferred hand the preferred hand can let go of the bush and pull the bunny ear. Pull both loops tight



Remember: when tying shoelaces you never hold the end of the laces, always work from as close to the shoe as possible!
